PokmonThere are a number of differences between the mechanics of Pokmon in the core games and those of Mystery Dungeon. Instead, each Pokmon has a set of base stats, which increase by fixed amounts when they level up. Stats may further increase through the use of Gummis, health drinks, Sitrus Berries, and other items. Non-HP stats can be raised to a maximum of 255; HP can be raised to at most 500 in Pokmon Mystery Dungeon: Gates to Infinity, each Pokmon has a fixed body size that is represented as a number from 0 to 4. When taking a team into a dungeon, the combined body size of the Pokmon in the team may not exceed a certain dungeon. The Speed stat did not exist prior to Pokmon Super Mystery Dungeon. Mystery Dungeon DX is a remaster of the Pokmon Mystery Dungeon Blue Rescue team games that came out in the early noughties, and one of DX's headline revisions is how it looks. The pixel art is gone, replaced with a kind of watercolour splash, and as such you're reminded, a bit, of that classic quest in Oblivion (no that's not the game I was thinking of) where you're stuck inside a painting. Then there's the fact you are literally a human trapped inside the body of a Pokmon, and that you keep having these rather disturbing dreams, and all the contrast and saturation seems to be dialled-up beyond the natural average, and yes.
